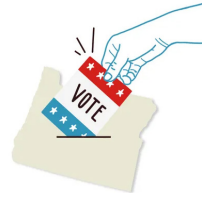

But how is OCC structured?

We started with a five-member Board of Directors. To that, we added The OCC 13, our advisory board, each expert representing one key issue that affects our state and upon which future policy statements will be based.

From there, we began recruiting members in all 36 Oregon counties and forming chapters.

Our first group of 100 members was dubbed "The 100." They came aboard early after our founding, and took a leap of faith by joining our new group.
